Smoking/Tobacco/Vaping Use: Any student found smoking cigarettes or using electronic smoking devices, personal vaporizers, or chewing tobacco on school property will serve a 2- day OSS. Electronic smoking devices can be used to deliver a controlled dangerous substance and/or chemical or chemical compound and therefore, are considered drug paraphernalia. As a result, there is reasonable suspicion that students who use these devices may be under the influence and a medical examination will be required as per SBOE Policy # 5131.6. In the event of a positive drug screen an additional 2- day OSS will be issued.
