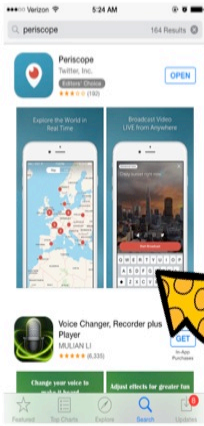


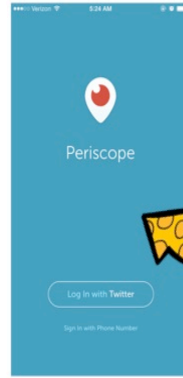
# Step One



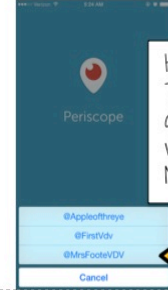
Download the Periscope App on your smartphone or iPad.



# Step Two



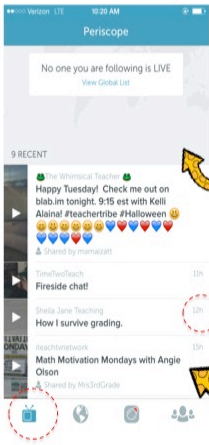
When you click on the app, this is the screen you will see. The easiest way to log into Periscope is to use your Twitter account! If you don't have a Twitter account, you can use your phone number.



If you are logged in on Twitter on your smart device, once you hit Login with Twitter your Twitter Name(s) will appear.



# Step Three



This is where you will find recent and live Periscopes. A Periscope is able to be viewed for 24 hours.

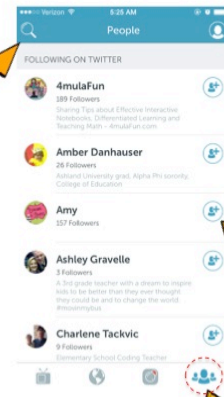
If any of the people you are following are streaming LIVE, you will see their name and a still frame of their video here.

Periscopes listed here are still able to be watched. Note that if you are watching a Periscope after it was LIVE, you are unable to comment. The number on the left shows you how many hours ago the Periscope was live.

When you click on the TV, this is what you will see!

Clicking the people on the bottom right will allow you to find people that you follow on Twitter who ALSO have a Periscope!



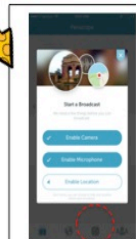
# Step Five

The globe option allows you to find Periscopers around the world who are live streaming!

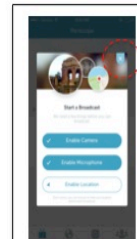


# Ready to Go?

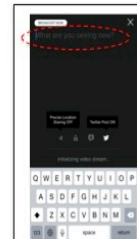
If you are ready to Periscope, follow the steps below!



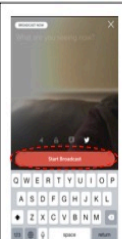
Be sure to click: Enable Camera and Enable Microphone. Enabling location will allow anyone viewing your periscope to know your exact location if you wish to disable this, simply click it. The oval will turn white when it is disabled.



Click the 'X'



Type a title for your Periscope. This is what people will see when they get a notification about your live stream!



When you are ready click: Start Broadcast.
